Electricity reached Palafrugell in 1900,

via the hydroelectric plant in Molí de Pals.



In 1910, L'Energia was created.

This was the substation that distributed electricity to the whole of Palafrugell.



L'Energia is an Eclectic-Modernist building,



which means that it mixes elements of the Modernist style



with other styles.



It was designed by Pere Domènech i Roura,



the son of the Modernist architect Lluís Domènec i Montaner.



The construction had two buildings.

Only one remains, the larger one,

on the corner of Pi i Margall Road



and Manufacturas del Corcho Road.



The building has large, arch windows,



with wrought-iron bars,



that are decorated with leaves and flowers made of iron.



It was reformed in 2015
