Around the 18th century, the building where fishermen would dye their nets



was built by the Sant Pere Guild of Fisherman



in Voltes Road, in Calella.



By 1986, the building hadn't been used



for dyeing nets for a long time.



The Guild of Fishermen gave the building to the Town Hall.



The Town Hall opened a tourist office there.



The building was remodelled between 2007 and 2009.



The tourist office was renovated.



An interpretation centre was added,



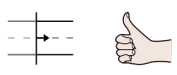
giving information about Calella's fishing guild.
