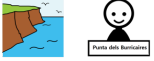


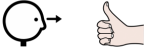
**PUNTA DELS BURRICAIRES**

we can see Calella's traditional maritime features,



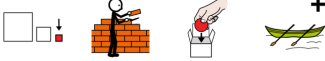
as well as features of the new, touristic Calella.

These were small buildings where the boats were kept.



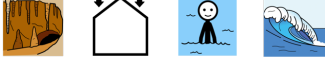
On the other side, we find the first tourist apartments.
