

## PALAFRUGELL MARKET



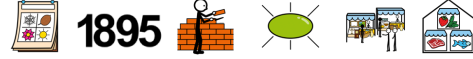
Originally, the market was held outdoors,



in Cavallers Road.



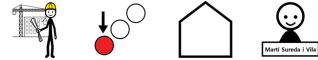
In 1895, a new, covered market was built



beside the church.



The architect was Martí Sureda i Vila.



At first, the new market contained



the same stalls as the old market.



In the end, only meat and poultry,



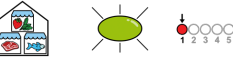
It re like chickens, hens and geese, were sold there.



It remains that way to this day.



The new market was one of the first



covered markets in the province of Girona.



It stood out because it was very simple and practical.



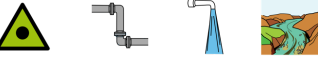
It was hygienic, well-lit and well-ventilated,



thanks to its large openings, a dual roof system



and waste-water drainage.



In the 1960s, the Fish Market was built



where the old Town Hall used to be.



The current building is a reconstruction



that was opened in 1987.
