Llafranc stopped being a fishing village



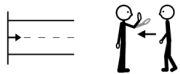
from 1950 onwards.

and Tomás Cervera.



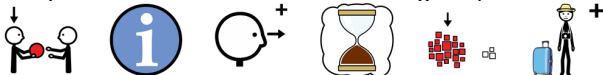
The tourist information offices in Llafranc, Saureda in Palafrugell and
