Aigua Dolça, Tamariu and Es Portió



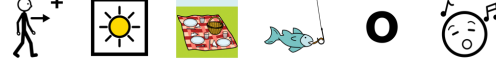
are the three beaches which make up the bay.



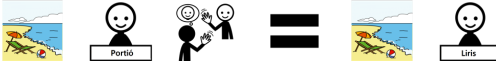
They were also the places where the families of Palafrugell
